Jack the Ripper is a shadow with whom everyone is familiar.

On 31 August 1888, the brutally murdered body of prostitute Mary Ann Nichols was found at 3:40am. So began London's autumn of fear when four subsequent – and similarly vicious - murders occurred in the East End each baffling police.

Ever since that fateful night, the world has been mesmerised by Jack the Ripper. Notes from the perpetrator, written in blood, were sent 'From Hell' but his true identity has never been discovered. Theories abound – was he a doctor? the future King? a tortured artist?

On Saturday, 14 April answers may be yours when we meet at Whitechapel Gallery and John Steel, of Tour de Force London, leads us on a walking tour that will bring us back to the London of Jack's day and indeed his very hunting ground...
